Welcome back to another school term. We hope everyone has had a refreshing break during the last two weeks.



ANZ Olympic Schools Programme—
Whenuakite School has registered to be part of this programme.



ANZ has developed the ANZ Olympic Schools Programme with the New Zealand Olympic Committee to inspire and motivate New Zealand's youth, through the celebration of the Olympic Games. Schools will be provided with resources and merchandise to provide opportunities, activities and incentives for students to live the Olympic Values.

In addition to the great resources our school will receive, ANZ has tailored the programme so their staff can personally help schools earn ANZ

Awards Centre credits and also secure the chance to have an Olympic Ambassador visit our school. For every **home loan** drawn down with ANZ we can earn credits for our school to spend on items from the ANZ Awards Centre such as sports equipment or computers. As an example, an eligible home loan drawn down by someone linked to our school to the value of \$50k or more will entitle our school to 800 credits. 800 credits equates to approximately \$400 of spending power at the ANZ Awards centre.


